What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship, combines hands-on work with the opportunity to train and obtain qualifications. It's also a paid position, so you earn while you learn. At least 20% of your time is set aside for class room learning and 80% is spent applying your knowledge and skills in the actual workplace, doing the job that you set out to get.

These are the different apprenticeship levels:

- 2 (Intermediate): GCSEs
- 3 (Advanced): A-levels
- 4 (Higher): foundation degree
- 5 (Higher): foundation degree/first year of bachelor's degree
- 6 (Degree): bachelor's degree
- 7 (Degree): master's degree
