## WATERSHED

### Work Experience Weeks 2023

#### Dates:

- Years 10 + 11 – Monday 26<sup>th</sup> to Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023
- Years 12 + 13 – Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> to Friday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023

[Watershed](#) is a cinema and cultural hub in Bristol City Centre and home to the [Pervasive Media Studio](#).

The Pervasive Media Studio is a space inside Watershed where exciting ideas that use creative technologies are invented, discussed, made and tested. Creative technologies includes things like robotics, mobile, sensor-based, interactive screen, tangible and/or immersive technologies. Watershed also has a long history of supporting people to tell stories, make, watch and critique films too. We are passionate about supporting creatives to develop their practice and businesses. We host lots of events and offer a physical home (including desk, meeting and event space) for creatives who combine arts, creativity and technology in their work. There is always a lot going on!

Watershed are offering young people who might be interested in a creative career, a five day work experience. Students will be invited undertake tasks with and alongside peers from across Bristol. Activities will include:

- Learning more about and experimenting with creative technology, visual communication and film critique (no experience necessary)
- Undertaking a practical project to develop and create individual written and/or visual content supported by the Watershed team, increasing confidence in creative expression
- Learning about different job roles at a large arts organisation like Watershed. Each day will start with a check in and introduction to a staff member who works at Watershed who will let participants know about their role and the career path that led them to work with us.

These sessions will take place over five days from 10am to 3pm (with regular breaks) at Watershed in the Harbourside area of Bristol (BS1 5TX). DBS checked Watershed staff members will be present throughout.

#### Who is it for:

We're interested to hear from Bristol-based students who want to learn more about careers in the creative industries and have an interest in developing their own creative work. You don't need a creative track record or any previous experience. If you're interested in working creatively and want to 'have a go', that's good enough for us.

We are particularly interested to hear from students in receipt of free school meals or who do not have any connections / familial ties to the creative industries.

We also recognise the creative industries are majority white, cisgender and non-disabled. We believe our work will be stronger with greater diversity and welcome applications from those who bring difference.

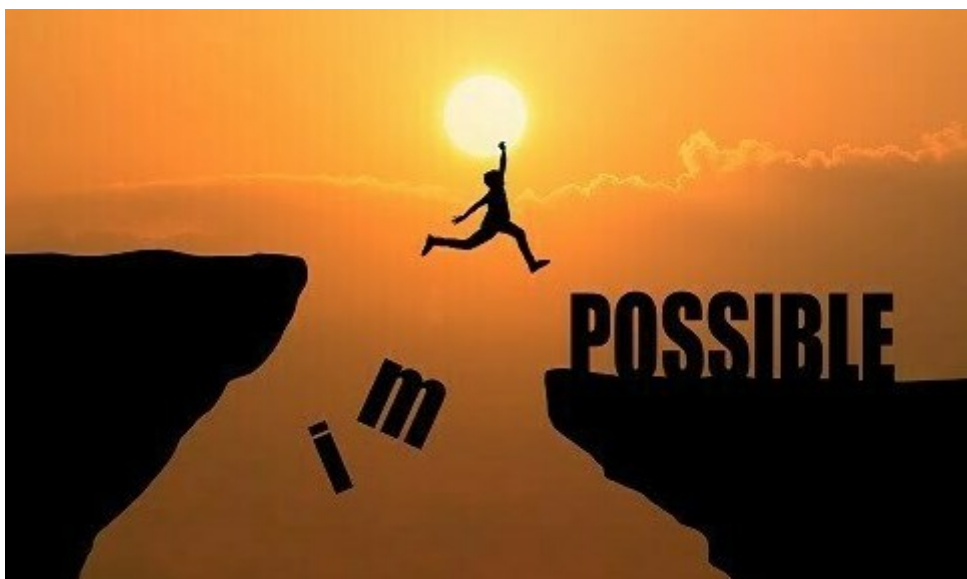
## Welcome to Nuffield Research Placements
