

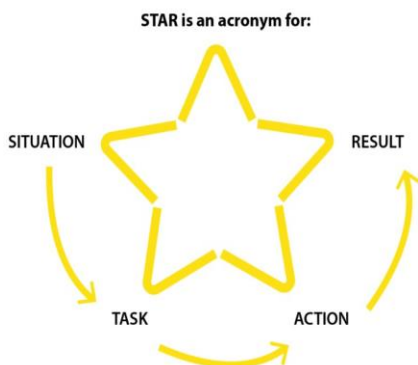
Ensure your phone is on silent and put away

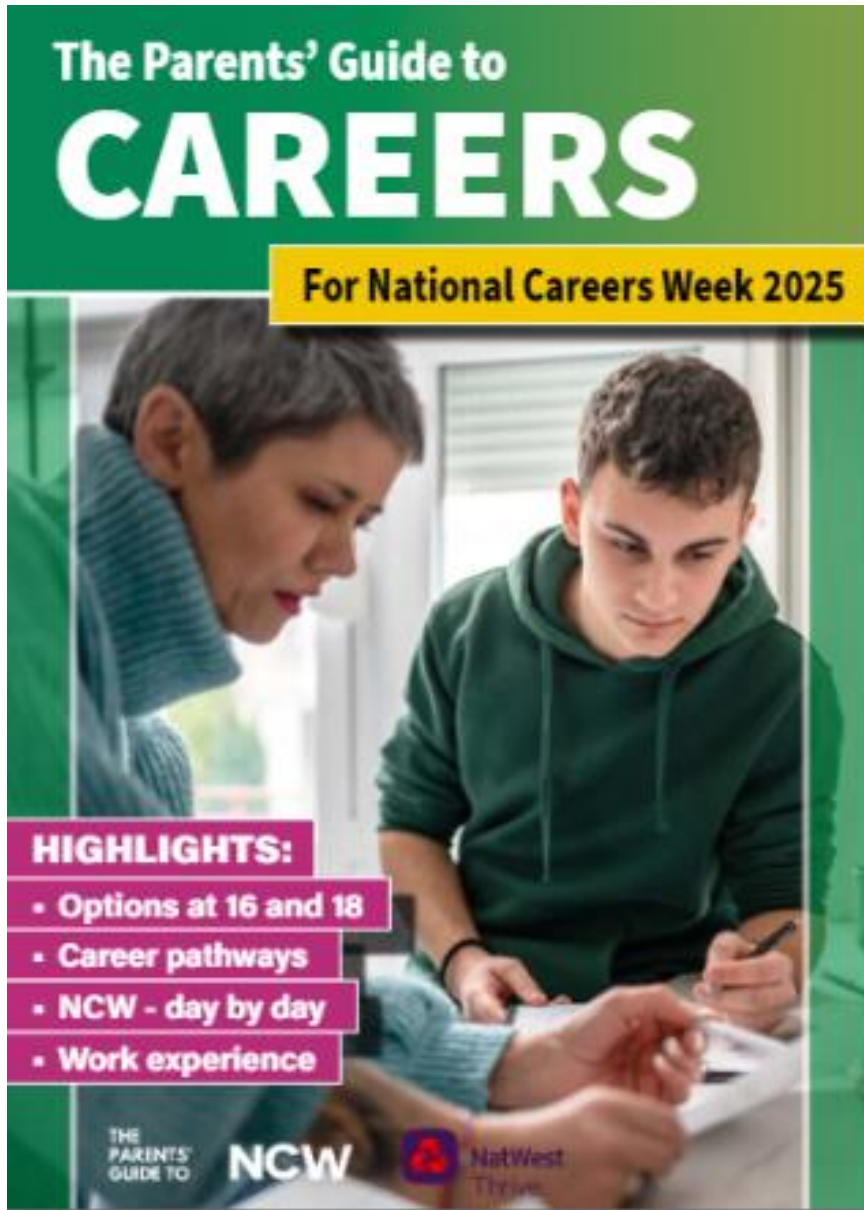
