



SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS

Bangor's Sports Scholarship scheme aims to recognise and support sporting excellence and achievement. The Scholarships, which are worth up to £3,000 a year, aren't limited to any particular sport or to students on any specific courses. However, in most cases, preference will be given to those individuals who will be able to represent Bangor University in the British University and Colleges Sport (BUCS) competitions.

To be eligible for consideration for a Sports Scholarship, you must:

- Be likely to achieve a podium, or points scoring position at the appropriate BUCS championship
- Be a European, Commonwealth or World level competitor in your chosen sport
- Not currently be competing in a sport or at a level that provides prize money.





I joined BAE Systems two years ago as a Level 4 Software Engineer apprentice straight after completing Sixth Form where I studied A-level Maths, Physics and Further Maths. While I had no previous technical experience or qualifications, I spent time after school learning on code academy and competing in cyber competitions, which ignited my interest in tech.

During Sixth Form there was a lot of emphasis on going to university. I knew early on that this wasn't something I wanted to do. I wanted to learn on the job and get hands on experience I could apply my education to.

I originally wanted to go into Cyber Security, and admittedly software engineering wasn't something I had considered until I saw an advert for BAE Systems National Security Academy which was local to me in Gloucester. I was attracted to the scheme by the work the business does in national security which helps to make the UK safer and more prosperous.


What does your apprenticeship mean to you?

My apprenticeship is my pathway into the working world without having to go to the 'traditional' university route. I get the best of both worlds as secure technical knowledge for my job without having to sit in a classroom and commit for the length of the Degree but I'm still able to thrive and progress in my career. My learning has been delivered through a 14 week virtual bootcamp as well as on the job.

What advice would you give to someone wanting to apply for an apprenticeship?

I would recommend that anyone about to take that first step out of education nurtures their LinkedIn profile. Having one helped me to find different roles and for recruiters to see my skills and interests, while starting to build a network. Do things in your free time that relate to your aspirations. I spent some of my free time learning with Immersive Labs, code academy and I competed in cyber competitions at school, which gave me the first-hand experience that inspired me to pursue a career in technology which was well received in interviews.

BAE SYSTEMS



Apprenticeships are for everyone! I started alongside 20 other apprentices, all from different backgrounds and of varying ages

What does a typical day look like for you?

A typical day for me starts off by getting in the office at 7am. The perks of flexible working means that I can start my day early and finish early. I begin by checking my emails and review any open pull requests (the code of the other developers on my team). Once my team are all in, we have a 'Stand up' which is where we all get together and discuss what we did yesterday, what we are going to do today and any bugs that we may have encountered. Following this, I start working on my tickets ensuring that I work through all the stages of the Software Development Lifecycle. The languages I tend to code in are Python and JavaScript. I am also required to attend other meetings which relate directly to my work along with other colleagues. My days follow a similar routine, but the tasks I work on are quite different and challenging (which I enjoy).
















Work Experience Week 2024 Information + application process

What is Watershed's work experience programme 2024?

For this year's work experience programme, we are inviting a group of students to join us in the Pervasive Media Studio for one week, where they will work together in teams to design and prototype an immersive experience, which they will showcase at a sharing event at end of the week.

For us 'Immersive experiences' mean art or tech projects which use technology in some way to connect the audience to the work, generally in an interactive way.

Immersive art projects often involve film, audio, projections, mixed reality, VR, music, but can include lots of different things. The projects you make will depend on the skills and interests of the teams you form. Don't worry if you haven't heard of immersive experiences before, we will explore what they are together.

Who is this for?

Building an immersive experience requires people with a wide range of interests inputting their skills. 


